Question 1

A 25-year-old man with Duchenne muscular dystrophy is scheduled for an emergent laparotomy for a perforated bowel. What cardiac condition is **MOST** commonly associated with this disease?

Question 2

Which of the following factors is the **MOST** important determinant of the spread of epidural block?

- b. height of patient
- c. *site of insertion (CORRECT ANSWER)
- d. volume of injection

Question 3

All EXCEPT ONE of the following are absolute indications for lung separation. Indicate the exception.

- a. bronchopleural fistula
- b. bronchoalveolar lavage
- c. *thoracoscopy (CORRECT ANSWER)
- d. massive pulmonary hemorrhage

Question 4

A 56-year-old man undergoes cardiac catheterization. He is found to have an end-diastolic volume of 120 mL, a total stroke volume of 60 mL, and a heart rate of 80 bpm. What would be the calculated ejection fraction?

- a. 25%
- b. 33%
- c. 40%
- d. *50% (CORRECT ANSWER)

Question 5

The differential diagnosis of a seizure in a woman in active labor includes all **EXCEPT ONE** of the following. Indicate the exception.

- a. Cortical vein thrombosis
- b. *Abruptio placentae (CORRECT ANSWER)
- **c.** Eclampsia
- d. Amniotic fluid embolism
