



Personal Achievement Awards

The Royal College awards program honours individual contributions to specialty medicine and surgery in Canada and around the globe.

Royal College AMS Donald Richards Wilson Award for CanMEDS Integration

About	This award is given annually to a medical educator or an identified leader of a team, program, or department who has demonstrated excellence and innovation in integrating the CanMEDS roles into a Royal College or other health related training program.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	\$2,000 accompanied by an engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>AMS Donald Richards Wilson Award</u>

Royal College Dr. Thomas Dignan Indigenous Health Award

About	This award acknowledges and celebrates Canadian physicians or physicians-in-training who epitomize a zeal and devotion to Canadian Indigenous rights and the dogged pursuit of justice for Canada's Indigenous people.
Eligibility	Open to Canadian physicians, residents or medical students.
Value	\$1,000 accompanied by an engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>Dr. Thomas Dignan Indigenous Health Award</u>

Duncan Graham Award in Medical Education

About	This award is conferred upon an individual, in recognition of outstanding lifelong contribution to medical education.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	\$1,000 accompanied by an engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>Duncan Graham Award</u>

Personal Achievement Awards

International Residency Educator of the Year Award

About	This award is conferred upon an international residency educator who has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing residency education as evidenced by innovation and impact beyond his/her program.
Eligibility	Post-Graduate educator outside Canada.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, International Conference on Residency Education (ICRE) registration.
Closing	Early spring annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>International Residency Educator of the Year Award</u>

International Resident Leadership Award

About	This award is conferred upon an international resident who has demonstrated leadership in specialty education and encourages the development of future leaders in medicine.
Eligibility	Enrolled in a postgraduate training program outside of Canada.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, International Resident Leadership Summit (IRLS) registration.
Closing	Early spring annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>International Resident Leadership Award</u>

James H. Graham Award of Merit

About	This award is conferred upon a person whose outstanding achievements reflect the aims and objectives of the Royal College.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College Convocation at which the award is conferred.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>James H. Graham Award of Merit</u>

Personal Achievement Awards

KJR Wightman Award for Scholarship in Ethics

About	The Royal College presents this award for scholarship in ethics for the best scholarly paper developed by a resident.
Eligibility	Resident in a Royal College accredited residency program.
Value	\$1,000 monetary award along with a certificate.
Closing	Spring annually, see website for exact date.
Apply	<u>KJR Wightman Award for Scholarship in Ethics</u>

Kristin Sivertz Resident Leadership Award

About	This award is conferred upon a resident who has demonstrated leadership in Canadian specialty education and encourages the development of future leaders in medicine.
Eligibility	Resident enrolled in a Royal College accredited post-graduate program.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, IRLS registration.
Closing	Early spring annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>Kristin Sivertz Resident Leadership Award</u>

Charles Peter W. Warren History of Medicine Essay Prize

About	This essay prize is awarded to a resident for the best scholarly essay pertaining to the history of specialty medicine, the history of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and/or the history of Post-Graduate Medical Education in Canada.
Eligibility	Residents in a Royal College accredited program or Fellows within two years of having completed training.
Value	\$1,500 and mentorship for securing publication.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Apply	<u>Peter Warren History of Medicine Essay Prize</u>

Personal Achievement Awards

Program Administrator Award for Innovation and Excellence

About	This award is conferred upon a Residency Program Administrator (PA) who has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing residency education as evidenced by innovation and excellence beyond his/her program.
Eligibility	Program administrators for Royal College accredited residency programs.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, PA conference registration.
Closing	Early spring annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>Program Administrator Award for Innovation and Excellence</u>

Program Director of the Year Award

About	This award is conferred upon a program director who has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing residency education as evidenced by innovation and impact beyond his/her program.
Eligibility	Current Program Directors for Royal College accredited residency programs.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, ICRE registration.
Closing	Early spring annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>Program Director of the Year Award</u>

Regional Mentor of the Year Award

About	This award is conferred upon a person who has demonstrated excellent role model qualities or competencies of Leader, Scholar and Professional as described in the CanMeds Framework.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellows.
Value	Engraved memento, honored at a regional event.
Closing	Late winter annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>Regional Mentor of the Year Award</u>

Personal Achievement Awards

Regional Prix d'Excellence / Specialist of the Year

About	This award is conferred upon a person who has made significant contributions in providing outstanding care to their patients and the community in which they practice.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellows.
Value	Engraved memento, honored at a regional event.
Closing	Late winter annually, see website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>Regional Prix d'Excellence / Specialist of the Year</u>

Teasdale-Corti Humanitarian Award

About	This award acknowledges and celebrates Canadian physicians who, while providing health care or emergency medical services, go beyond the accepted norms of routine practice, which may include exposure to personal risk. The recipient's actions will exemplify altruism and integrity, courage and perseverance in the alleviation of human suffering.
Eligibility	Open to Canadian physicians worldwide.
Value	Engraved memento, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the award is conferred, usually at Convocation.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>Teasdale-Corti Humanitarian Award</u>

International Collaboration Award

About	This award is presented to individuals (Fellows or non-Fellows) who have demonstrated leadership and excellence in advancing post-graduate medical education and residency training outside Canada, through but not limited to enacting, participating in, or promoting Royal College frameworks, programs and/or collaborations.
Eligibility	Open to medical educators or leaders of a team, program or department outside of Canada.
Value	Framed certificate presented at a Royal College event relevant to the recipient or at an event in the home country of the recipient.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	<u>International Collaboration Award</u>

Professional Development Grants

Grants provide funding for research and professional development across a wide range of disciplines, health settings and environments.

Regional Continuing Professional Development Activity Grant

About	Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Activity grants are provided to physician organizations to assist in the development of accredited learning activities.
Eligibility	Regional or provincial physician organization. An organization may receive funding once every 2 fiscal years.
Value	\$2,000.00 per event.
Closing	Accepted year-round, contingent on funding availability.
Apply	Regional Continuing Professional Development Grant

Regional Professional Development Grant

About	Supports self-learning activities that are prospectively planned by individual Fellows in collaboration with a mentor, supervisor or instructor. Can be developed as individual traineeships to learn a skill or expand an area of competence relevant to one's scope of practice, or can support participation in formal courses.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellow residing in Canada. Fellows may receive funding once every five fiscal years.
Value	Up to \$4,000.00.
Closing	Accepted year-round, contingent on funding availability.
Apply	Regional Professional Development Grant

Research Grants

Medical Education Research Grant

About	Supports high quality research in Canada that will advance the field of postgraduate medical education or continuing professional development.
Eligibility	Any individual, however a Fellow of the Royal College must contribute to the research project.
Value	Up to \$25,000 per year to a maximum of \$50,000 per project.
Closing	Late winter annually, see website for exact date.
Apply	Medical Education Research Grant

Robert Maudsley Fellowship for Studies in Medical Education

About	This fellowship helps specialists acquire knowledge and skills in the field of medical education in order to develop educational programs, evaluation methods and medical education research.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellows.
Value	Up to \$40,000 per year of study.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Apply	Robert Maudsley Fellowship for Studies in Medical Education

Research Grants

Royal College / AMS CanMEDS Research Development Grant

About	Supports research, development, and/or implementation of projects that enhance specialty education through the key CanMEDS including faculty development, course development and/or medical education research.
Eligibility	Any individual, however a Fellow of the Royal College must contribute to the research project.
Value	Up to \$25,000.
Closing	Late winter annually, see website for exact date.
Apply	Royal College / AMS CanMEDS Research Grant

Strategic Calls

About	Periodically, the Royal College issues strategic calls for proposals for research in specific topics in medical education.
Eligibility	Any individual, however a Fellow of the Royal College must contribute to the research project.
Value	Varies.
Closing	Varies, depending on timing of the call.
Apply	Royal College Research Grant



Travelling Fellowships

Travelling Fellowships support the professional development of individuals working on a wide range of medical issues.

Detweiler Travelling Fellowship

About	This fellowship will enable the recipient to visit a medical centre in Canada (other than their own) or abroad, to study or gain experience in the use or application of new knowledge or techniques <i>or</i> to further the pursuit of a project relevant to clinical practice or research.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellows, and residents in their last year of training in a Royal College accredited program.
Value	Junior applicants will receive up to \$21,000, Senior applicants will receive up to \$10,500.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Apply	<u>Detweiler Travelling Fellowship</u>

Harry S. Morton Travelling Fellowship in Surgery

About	This fellowship provides funds for Canadian surgeons and surgical residents travelling to the UK and may be used to support surgery-related clinical, scientific, or medical education studies or research.
Eligibility	Royal College Fellows, and residents in their last year of training in a Royal College accredited program.
Value	Monetary award up to \$50,000/year for two years.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Apply	<u>Harry S. Morton Travelling Fellowship in Surgery</u>

Visiting Professorships

Visiting Professorships help broaden knowledge and foster scientific dialogue in specialty medicine.

Balfour Mount Visiting Professor in Palliative Medicine*

About	This professorship brings distinguished international lecturers in palliative care to health science faculties in Canada to engage in discussion about, and to lecture on, the physical, psycho-social and spiritual needs of patients requiring palliative care.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	Honorarium, travel and expenses to hosting faculty.
Closing	Second Friday in September, biennially.
Nominate	Balfour Mount Visiting Professor in Palliative Medicine

* offered biennially in odd years

Harry S. Morton Lectureship in Surgery

About	The purpose of this lectureship is to advance and to promote study of and research in surgical training and the practice of surgery, by providing support for a nominated surgeon from the United Kingdom to travel to a Canadian centre.
Eligibility	Surgeons from the UK, nominated by a Canadian Faculty of Medicine or National Specialty Society.
Value	Monetary award up to \$7,000 to cover expenses.
Closing	Second Friday in September, annually.
Nominate	Harry S. Morton Lectureship in Surgery

Janes Visiting Professorship in Surgery *

About	The purpose of this visiting professorship is to stimulate and increase an interest in the latest developments in surgery and surgical techniques.
Eligibility	Preferably a Canadian surgeon.
Value	Travel and expenses, up to \$7,000.00, to visit up to three Canadian medical schools.
Closing	Second Friday in September, biennially.
Nominate	Janes Visiting Professorship in Surgery

* offered biennially in even years

Visiting Professorships

John G. Wade Visiting Professorship in Patient Safety and Simulation—Based Medical Education

About	This award supports a distinguished educator to visit a Royal College accredited simulation centre in Canada, in order to promote the use of simulation in medical education, and its applications to improving patient safety.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	\$1,000 honorarium, plus travel and expenses up to \$3,000.00.
Closing	September, annually. See website for exact date.
Nominate	<u>John G. Wade Visiting Professorship in Patient Safety and Simulation</u>

KJR Wightman Visiting Professorship in Medicine *

About	The visiting professor participates in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and in discussions with peers, both in internal medicine and in the professor's particular area of academic interest.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	Travel and expenses up to \$7,000.00.
Closing	Second Friday in September, biennially.
Apply	<u>KJR Wightman Visiting Professorship in Medicine</u>

* offered biennially in even years

McLaughlin-Gallie Visiting Professorship

About	The visiting professor participates in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching, and in the exchange of ideas with staff, researchers and undergraduate and postgraduate students. Themes for the VP are selected annually by the Awards Committee.
Eligibility	No restrictions.
Value	Travel and expenses up to \$7,000.00.
Closing	June 30 annually.
Nominate	<u>McLaughlin-Gallie Visiting Professorship</u>

Honorary Fellowship Award

One of the most prestigious awards offered by the Royal College to individuals not eligible for Fellowship.

Honorary Fellowship

About	Honorary Fellowship is one of the most prestigious awards that the Royal College can bestow. Since 1933, we have invited exceptional physicians, surgeons and lay persons who are not eligible for Fellowship to become Honorary Fellows.
Eligibility	Anyone not previously certified by the Royal College.
Value	Royal College Honorary Fellowship, certificate, travel and expenses to Royal College event at which the Fellowship is bestowed (usually Convocation).
Closing	November, annually. See website for exact date.
Nominate	Honorary Fellowship
